What is Pre-School Karate?

Pre-school Karate aims to assist in helping with the development of the child. The first 3 - 6 years of a child's life is certainly the most important development years in which most patterns and models get formed in a child's memory. Through exercise the child is helped to develop. Attention specifically is given to the following:
